The Towpath Taskforce has been very busy around the basin area over the last few months. We have been painting benches and tables outside the visitor centre, and tackling the foliage in the old warehouse carpark, making sure that the walkway is accessible for visitors. The area from the car park towards the canal is constantly being addressed as the vegetation gets out of hand after a few rainy days. The basin car park is one that we have to tidy up every month. On our last workday we started to tackle the weeds on the parapets of the aqueduct. Our team was armed with trowels and hoes and we ended up



on our knees on the aqueduct, leaning through the railings to clear the vegetation. It can get a bit awkward for visitors to walk around us, and some walkers decide not to pass as they feel unsettled by not being able to hold on to the railings. We try to make an early start before the area gets too busy and we get some interesting comments about our 'extreme weeding' sessions! We were also serenaded by the world renowned harpist, Catrin Finch, outside the visitor centre.

The Taskforce members are from different areas, with the furthest travelling from Shrewsbury. Our Supervisor reminds us the day before our meeting, and we meet up at the grey shed, near the basin car park at 10 am. He provides all the necessary tools and we discuss the jobs that need to be done. So if you would like to join us, why not come along and meet us on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays every month, at 10 am.

First of all let me say a great big thank you for re-electing me to serve as your County Councillor for the next few years. I will endeavour to repay your faith in me and serve you to the best of my ability.

Wrexham is now a City and we will see what benefits and changes that will bring us in the future.

During the run up to the Election, County Councillors were basically put on the sidelines and Council business was temporarily put on hold, but now things are back to normal so please don't hesitate to contact me if you think I can be of assistance. Regarding the proposed Multi-Purpose track from Trevor to Llangollen, I am hopeful that the first portion of land will be purchased in the coming weeks. Negotiations are still on-going for the remainder of the land and I will keep you informed.

The ever present problem of dog fouling continues to cause a nuisance in the area. In addition to the known hot spots of canal towpaths and the old railway line, it would now appear that private landowners are also being bothered by fouling occurring on public footpaths that cross their land. This can prove dangerous to farm animals and humans.

The historical problem of car parking around the WHS is still with us. A meeting is being arranged between the Council and the Canal and River Trust in the near future. Every avenue explored to date has proved to be a dead end and this is proving extremely frustrating. This problem has been with us for years and we need a speedy resolution. You will be kept informed.

Recipe for Gooey Brownies

Recipe - Makes 36

225g soft margarine 4 eggs beaten 110g dark chocolate Pinch of salt

400g castor sugarhalf tsp baking powder100g walnut pieces2 tsp vanilla extract

170g plain flour

Method

Preheat oven to 160c / 320f / gas mark 2-3. Melt margarine and chocolate together.

Remove from heat. Add sugar and mix well. Add vanilla, eggs and walnut pieces.

Sift flour, salt and baking powder, and then fold into chocolate mixture.

Pour into a lightly greased 30 x 20 x 3 cm tray. Bake for approx. 50 mins.

Remove from oven and allow the brownies to cool.



Our Picturesque Landscape Project

The Dee Valley Picturesque bus service is running again to provide access to some of the key destinations in this beautiful and historic landscape. The service is a circular route running every Saturday from May until October 2022, and links Llangollen and the surrounding villages to popular local attractions including Pontcysyllte Aqueduct, Wenffrwd Nature Reserve, Horseshoe Falls, Valle Crucis Abbey, Plas Newydd Historic House and the Horseshoe Pass.



The service enables people to visit these key locations without the need of a car, reduces the need for parking spaces, and helps to reduce congestion at some of the busiest sites in the Dee Valley.

A great option would be to get on the bus at the main Pontcysyllte Aqueduct Queen Street car park, Cefn Mawr, take the bus to Horseshoe Falls and walk back along the canal.

The service provides both visitors and local residents with the opportunity to explore the wider area. The bus offers hop on/ hop off facility with a 1Bws ticket price allowing unlimited travel on the service through the day. Welsh bus pass holders travel free and dogs are welcome to travel for 50p. The bus can carry one wheelchair.
